FACTOR #8 **REPORTING**

Regular reporting on actions taken and risks being addressed is formally reported to the leadership, stakeholders, employees, customers and authorities for compliance.

The outcomes of planned actions, new risks or events are assessed and considered in updated risk and action plans.

FACTOR #1 **RAISING AWARENESS**

There is a common understanding across the organisation of the need to address concerns, risks and opportunities presented by climate change.

FACTOR #2 STRATEGIC PLANNING

The organisation's strategy for implementing it's vision recognises the need to act on risks and opportunities presented by climate change.

FACTOR #6 **ADAPTION PLANNING** & ACTION

Given the specific potential risks facing the organisation, there is a clear, actionable plan to reduce the likelihood or consequences.

FACTOR #5 **CARBON FOOTPRINT MITIGATION**

The organisation understands it's climate impact by way of carbon footprint from direct and indirect emissions and has an active mitigation plan.

FACTOR #3 **RISK ASSESSMENT**

An assessment of the risks associated with threats and opportunities presented by climate change, is documented.

FACTOR #4 **GOVERNANCE** & POLICY

Senior leadership including Board or governance group members are cognisant of climate-related risks and this is recognised in organisation policy.
